A large printed and hand-painted cotton Palampore panel, Indian, early 18th century, with large-scale design of ebullient floral palmettes, delicate grasses, shield medallions in-filled with pots of plants, 412 by 206cm

For an identical example see 'Origins of Chintz', V&A and Royal Ontario Museum, plate 85, catalogue no.88. The V&A have an identical example, accession no. IS41-1950. Two Palampore's with identical designs (one chintz, the second an embroidery) are preserved in the Rijksmuseum, Amsterdam. Large palmettes of the same type also appear in the chintz costumes of Friesland, the Netherlands.
