A fine embroidered lady's anteri robe, Ottoman, late 18th-early 19th century, formed from undulating striped cotton bands in pink, navy and ivory, heavily couched and embroidered with delicate curleque tracteries in metal thread and sequins, embroidered in fine chain stitch with stylised honeysuckle and other blossom in coloured silk outlined in gold, the hanging sleeves-lined in linen striped with pink silk embroidered with C scrolls and blossom in silks and gilt threads, fastened by silver thread toggles and loops
